## Challenges & opportunities for ports

#### Sustainable growth

- Growing costs Stable revenues
- Limited possibilities for physical growth of port platforms in the long run

#### **Opportunity**

Challenge

- Sustainable growth in strategic markets
- New service offerings impacting the supply chain

#### **Supply chain**

- The battle over the control of the supply chains : horizontal & vertical integration
- Creation of networks that will weaken the role of ports
- No consolidation yet of ports & port authorites
- Creation of networks based on knowledge & expertise

#### **Energy transition**

- Industrial transition near port clusters
- Competition import/export hubs green molecules
